In order to scale and plan the event as accurately as possible with respect to the anticipated number of participants, we kindly ask everyone to confirm their entry by paying the registration fee as soon as possible. Payable via credit card or Apple Pay on the event site smnor21.com/event

KEY DATES

The SMNOR21 world meet is scheduled 17-19/20 September 2021.

Sign up for the world meet in Norway! Both registration and payment is done via SMNOR21.no, information provided in a separate information box.

- Deadline to sign up is no later than 10. JUNE 2021.
- Deadline to pay registration fee and hotel fees are no later than 20. JUNE 2021.

The SMNOR21 organization is constantly monitoring ongoing government measures to combat the COVID19-pandemic. We will evaluate and make a final decision on whether to conduct the world meet or not. The final decision deadline is 1. JULY. All payments prior to this deadline will be refunded if the meeting is cancelled.

- 8) Drive carefully and arrive safely.

OPTIONS

There are two options, a two day stay or a three day stay

- 1) Option 1 – the MyLord option; Two night stay from 17- 19 at Hotel Alexandria, Loen
- 2) Option 2 – the Opera option; extend your stay to three nights, with an additional night from 19 – 20 at Hotel Brosundet, Aalesund

PROGRAM

REGISTRATION AND HOTEL FEES

Signing up is easily done via the website. The most important information is how many are in your party, and how many nights you are going to stay – MyLord (option 1) or Opera (option 2). It is also important to provide information on whether you require a single or a double room.

Registration fee – 500 Norwegian Kroner (NOK) per car entry

Hotel fee – based on the number of people and rooms (paid in NOK)

We prefer that you book & pay with credit card or Apple Pay on our website. Simply choose your rooms and options here <https://www.smnor21.com/event> and it will show up in your cart.

Should you not want to pay by credit card, please share your choice of rooms and lunch activity for Saturday with us in an email to booking@smnor21.com in order for us to produce a Pre-Payment Invoice for you.

The registration fee is used to cover administration costs incurred by the club and SMNOR21.

Drive-together-tour – Arrive-in-style 17. september (voluntary option)

Following the scenic drive during SMNOR21 Sunday 19. you may end your trip at Åndalsnes in the afternoon.

If you have time we recommend extending your trip and join us for an extended drive to the coastal town of Aalesund on Sunday evening. A joint dinner will be hosted at night. The next morning we will drive the Atlantic Ocean Road to Kristiansund which will conclude the official program of SMNOR21.

After completing the official program you may drive from Kristiansund via Oppdal to Oslo or continue north to Trondheim before heading south to Oslo. You may also of course continue on your own to any destination of choice.

*This trip includes scheduled ferry crossings (no booking required) and toll roads – paid individually.

What we all are wondering – including the SMNOR21-team

What about Covid-19?

First things first – national and international travel policies/restrictions in place during time of travel will apply to everyone traveling to SMNOR21.

At present international travel to Norway is regulated based on the infection rate of the country you are traveling from. Today quarantine and travel bans apply to most travel. Many countries are however in the initial stages of opening back up including Norway. We have good reason to expect that the world will look quite different by September 2021.

You are individually responsible to check travel eligibility from your country to Norway. We will keep you informed on the policies that apply inside Norway. SMNOR21 does not have any influence on local policies or travel restrictions.

We do however assure you that we are planning and preparing to host SMNOR2021 as if the pandemic is under control and quarantine free travel is possible in September 2021.

We are planning on taking the following precautions:

- Maximum 200 participants.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available at all locations where we gather including throughout the hotel.
- Guidelines from local authorities at the time of the event will be closely followed.
- Should a national or local face-mask policy be in place at the time of the event, participants will be issued appropriate face masks by SMNOR2021.
- All meals will be table service only, no buffet will be available.

Cancellation after 1. July – force majeure

SMNOR21 will reserve the right to a force majeure should Norwegian authorities put in place restrictions that make it impossible to host SMNOR21.

All hotel bookings will be cancelled and booking fees refunded should a national situation like this occur. Participants are personally responsible to follow up individual hotel, ferry or other bookings made in connection with your trip to SMNOR21.

The registration fee will not be refunded by SMNOR2021 if a force majeure is declared.

SMNOR21 is not responsible for bookings made with third parties that are not official partners of SMNOR21.
